

Golf Proposals for the KSHSAA

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Proposals to the KSHSAA for the Sport of Golf

Proposal #1: At the regional tournament, each team that qualifies for the State Tournament shall be awarded a plaque.

Rationale: A team should be rewarded when they have accomplished something. It is an accomplishment to qualify for the State Tournament and team should have a plaque to display at their school for years to come.

Proposal #2: Change the State Tournament from a 1 day 18 hole tournament, to a 2 day 36 hole tournament, to be held on any two consecutive days.

Rationale: A one day State Tournament leaves a lot to chance. The pairings from the regional tournament may not always put the best players together. On the second day of a two day tournament, each player as well as each team knows where they stand and knows what they will have to do in order to have a chance to finish at the top. It would require sustained superior play in order to win whereas a one day tournament allows one player to have a lucky day and be the state champion. Kansas is one of the only states, if not the only state, that still has the State Championship in golf determined by a one day tournament. A two day State Championship will usually have the best players and the best teams finish at the top, which is what a State Championship is supposed to do.

Proposal #3: Have a Kansas Golf Association rules official present at the regional and State Tournaments.

Rationale: Since there are many coaches who are not experts on rules it would be helpful to have a KGA rules official present to help in making rulings on any problems that may arise.

Proposal #4: Hold separate regional and state tournaments for class 5A and class 6A.

Rationale: The number of 5A and 6A schools now playing girls golf warrants the creation of two separate tournament structures, one for each class.

Proposal #2: Change the State Tournament from a 1 day 18 hole tournament, to a 2 day 36 hole tournament, to be held on any two consecutive days.

Rationale: A one day State Tournament leaves a lot to chance. The pairings from the regional tournament may not always put the best players together. On the second day of a two day tournament, each player as well as each team knows where they stand and knows what they will have to do in order to have a chance to finish at the top. It would require sustained superior play in order to win whereas a one day tournament allows one player to have a lucky day and be the state champion.
