 - C) To have a representation to whom may be referred athletic challenges of general interest in the hope of creating better relationships between schools and a sympathetic understanding among coaches.

- The Kansas Coaches Association is a voluntary organization not organized for profit.

- The members of the KCA Executive Board and the Sports Chairpersons serve on a voluntary basis.

- The Kansas Coaches Association is the only coaches' advisory organization to the Kansas State High School Activities Association. The hierarchy for recommendations to the KSHSAA from the KCA follow the steps listed below:
 - 1. Recommendations from the Sports Chairpersons of the KCA - documented by surveys from the coaches.
 - 2. Reception by and approval of the KCA Executive Board, who in turn is the liaison to the KSHSAA.
 - 3. Reception by the KSHSAA Executive Board as presented by the KCA Executive Board during the KSHSAA April Executive Board meeting.
 - 4. Reception by the KSHSAA Board of Directors.

THE CONSTITUTION OF:
KANSAS COACHES ASSOCIATION
REVISED AND BROUGHT UP TO DATE, AUGUST, 2011

ARTICLE I

NAME: The name of this organization shall be the "Kansas Coaches Association." It is a voluntary organization, not organized for profit, to qualify under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

ARTICLE II

OBJECTIVES: The objectives of the ASSOCIATION shall be:

- A. To promote harmonious relationships between the administrators and coaches in their respective schools and to work in a close cooperative way with the KSHSAA.
- B. To assist in promoting pure and wholesome, amateur, interscholastic athletics and the coaching profession and to work together for the improvement of conditions in Kansas school athletics.
- C. To secure a better understanding of the problems of coaching and to place at the disposal of coaches, sources of information for their use.
- D. To endeavor to improve athletics by aiding the coaches in securing a more thorough understanding of the various sports.
- E. To have a representative to whom may be referred athletic problems of general interest in the hope of creating better relationships between schools and a sympathetic understanding among coaches.
- F. To promote good fellowship, social contacts and understanding among coaches.

ARTICLE III

RESTRICTION: No part of the net earnings of the association shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the ASSOCIATION shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the articles hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the ASSOCIATION shall be the carrying on of , propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislations, and the ASSOCIATION shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other prevision of these articles, this ASSOCIATION shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this ASSOCIATION.

ARTICLE IV

DISSOLUTION: Upon the dissolution of the ASSOCIATION, the Executive Board shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the ASSOCIATION, dispose of all of the assets of the ASSOCIATION exclusively for the purpose of the ASSOCIATION in such a manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, as the executive board shall determine.

ARTICLE V

MEMBERSHIP:

- Section 1. Active membership shall include elementary, junior high/middle school, senior high, college educators and seasonal coaches regardless of race, sex or creed.
- Section 2. Membership shall extend from August 1 to July 31 of the next year.

ARTICLE VI

DUES:

- Section 1. The annual membership fee shall be \$30.00 per annum for all members, which shall include active membership in the National Federation of Coaches Association, and all of its privileges and the National High School Athletic Coaches Association.

ARTICLE VII

CANCELLATION OF MEMBERSHIP:

- Section 1. Membership in the ASSOCIATION shall be suspended at the end of the fiscal year. Suspension shall be lifted with payment of annual dues. The fiscal year of the ASSOCIATION shall be from August 1 to July 31 inclusive.
- Section 2. Any membership may be suspended by two-thirds vote of the Executive Board.
- Section 3. Any member whose membership has been canceled by a vote of the Executive Board may appeal directly to the ASSOCIATION for reinstatement at a regular annual meeting. The action of the majority members shall be final.

ARTICLE VIII

OFFICERS:

- Section 1. A 2nd Vice-President shall be elected by the members of the ASSOCIATION during the business meeting at the KSHSAA Coaching School and/or by electronic voting for (2) two year terms in the odd numbered years.
- Section 2. A Secretary shall be appointed by the Executive Board for a (2) two year term in the odd numbered years.
- Section 3. A KSHSAA Board of Director Member shall be appointed for a (2) two year term by the Executive Board. Said person shall have served in all elected offices of the ASSOCIATION.

- Section 4. The Executive Director/Treasurer shall be appointed by the executive board at each odd numbered election year meeting. To insure continuity in the ASSOCIATION, the Executive Director/Treasurer shall have served at least ten years consecutively on the executive board. The Executive Director/Treasurer shall be the treasurer and make a detailed financial report at the annual meeting of the ASSOCIATION. Said person shall pay all bills presented by the creditors of the ASSOCIATION and approved by the executive board. Said person's home address shall be the official address of the KANSAS COACHES ASSOCIATION for all business purposes.
- Section 5. The NFCA Representative shall be appointed for a (2) two year term by the Executive Board and is responsible for working with the KSHSAA-Kansas Coaches Association – National Federation High Schools Coaches Association Coaches of the Year Awards (August-October) and the selection of the KSHSAA Oscar Stauffer Sportswriter of the year award selection (January).
- Section 6. The past president shall serve a period of at least two years after their term as president, they shall serve until the current president moves to the past president position.
- Section 7. In order to be eligible for the office of President, the candidate must have served as a member of the Executive Board. The Vice-Presidents, elected by the membership, serve with the Secretary, Past-President, Executive Director/Treasurer, KSHSAA Board of Director representative, and the National Federation Coaches Association Representative on the Executive Board.
- Section 8. If an Executive officer resigns during his/her term of service, the Executive Board has the authority and responsibility to name a replacement to insure the efficiency of the office.

ARTICLE IX

DUTIES OF THE OFFICERS:

- Section 1. It shall be the duty of the President to perform such duties as pertain to the office. These are to include the presentation of all materials and recommendations to the KSHSAA, calling meetings of the Executive Board as is necessary in addition to other items of interest to the ASSOCIATION. The president shall have the power to appoint any necessary committees.
- Section 2. It shall be the duty of 1st Vice-President to perform such duties as pertain to the office. These are to include handling of the arrangements for the Coach of the Year awards for the official ballot, coordinate with the Board of sports advisors, receive their reports. Assume the duties of the President in case of death, absence or termination, attend the KSHSAA meetings with the President.

- Section 3. It shall be the duty of the 2nd Vice-President to perform such duties as pertain to the office. These are to include assisting the 1st Vice President in the selection of candidates for the official ballot. Assume the duties of the 1st Vice-President in case of death, absence or termination, attend the KSHSAA meetings with the President and 1st Vice-President, and working to arrange corporate financial support for the KANSAS COACHES ASSOCIATION.
- Section 4. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to handle all sales of the membership cards, send all revenue to the Treasurer, send a list of members to the members of the Executive Board, the NFCA, and any other organization that is in need of such list. The Secretary shall handle all other duties as are incident to this office.
- Section 5. It shall be the duty of the Executive Director/Treasurer to handle all correspondence with the state coaches associations. The Director/Treasurer shall give a financial report at the annual meeting. It shall be said persons duty to handle all revenue of the ASSOCIATION, pay all bills incurred by the ASSOCIATION and to keep a detailed account of finances. It shall be said persons duty to file all correct IRS forms with that organization after the end of the fiscal year.
- Section 6. The Past President shall serve as an active member of the Executive Board in an advisory capacity and shall attend all Executive Board meetings as called.
- Section 7. The KSHSAA Board of Directors representative shall serve a (2) two year period on the KSHSAA Board of Directors representing the views of the KANSAS COACHES ASSOCIATION.
- Section 8. The NFCA representative works with the KSHSAA for the selection of the Oscar Stauffer sports writer of the year award. They also compile and submit the coach of the year recipient information and nomination to the NFCA for further recognition.

ARTICLE X

MANAGEMENT:

The Executive Board:

- Section 1. The management of the affairs of the ASSOCIATION shall be vested in an Executive Board consisting of the President, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President, Secretary, Executive Secretary-Treasurer, past-president of the ASSOCIATION, the KSHSAA Board of Directors member and the NFCA representative .
- Section 2. All expenses of the Kansas Coaches School shall be approved by the Executive Board before the bills are paid.
- Section 3. The Executive Board shall meet subject to the call of the President and other meetings at the discretion of the Executive Board.

ARTICLE XI

BOARD OF SPORTS CHAIRPERSONS

- Section 1. There shall be a chairperson that shall report to the Executive Board in each sport.
- Section 2. Each chairperson shall have a maximum budget of \$250.00 from which all expenses incurred such as postage, telephone bills, mileage and rooms shall be taken.

Section 3. Allowances will be made for other projects within each sport subject to the approval from the Executive Board.

Section 4. Each chairperson will be provided annual guidelines by the Executive Board.

ARTICLE XII

MEETINGS:

- Section 1. A regular meeting of the ASSOCIATION shall be held at the annual Kansas Coaches School.
- Section 2. Officers shall receive .50 cents per mile for travel expenses to regular executive meetings of the ASSOCIATION, unless they waive the expenses to the ASSOCIATION.
- Section 3. The executive officers shall receive all expenses while conducting the ASSOCIATIONS business at coaching clinics and Executive Board meetings, unless they waive the expenses to the ASSOCIATION.
- Section 4. A quorum shall consist of the active members present, due notice having been given of the meeting.

ARTICLE XIII

ORDER OF BUSINESS:

The usual order of business shall be as follows:

ARTICLE XIV

AMENDMENTS:

- Section 1. Any proposed amendment shall be submitted in writing to a member of the Executive Board prior to any regular called meeting of the Executive Board.
- Section 2. The proposed amendment, together with the opinion of the Executive Board, shall be read at a regular meeting of the ASSOCIATION.
- Section 3. A two-thirds majority of the members present shall be necessary for the adoption of the said amendment.

ARTICLE XV

RESOLUTIONS:

- Section 1. Resolutions shall be adopted by a majority vote of active members present at the annual meetings.

Guidelines for Sports Chairs

There is a Sport Chair that will report to the Executive Board of the KCA in each sport. All Sport Chairs will be members of the Kansas Coaches Association and serve at least a two-year term. In order to help build a close working relationship between the KCA executive board and the KCA sports chairs persons, each sport has been assigned an executive board member to contact. Listed below are the board members and the sports they are assigned:

Crystal Kohman-Smith – Softball, Baseball, Swimming
Brad Smith – Football, Basketball
Stan Boggs – Tennis, Wrestling
Ginny Honomichl – Bowling, Gymnastics, Cross Country

Steve Curran – Golf
Diana Oborny – Volleyball, MS
Jackie Engle – Track, Soccer

The 1st Vice President (Brad Smith) is in charge collecting the Coach of the Year award information and may be contacting you also.

There are three parts to the Sport Chair job as listed below.

1. Each Sport Chair is responsible for surveying all of the coaches in their sport across the state of Kansas for recommendations of rule changes or procedures specific to their sport. The official KCA survey form (found on the next page) must be used to report all recommendations to the KCA.
 - A. The KCA survey form, which includes all survey results and recommendations, should be copied, completed, and forwarded to the KCA president no later than March 1.
 - B. Each Sport Chair may call and discuss recommendations and ask questions of the KSHSAA staff assigned to their sport. All recommendations must be turned into the KCA for presentation - not to the KSHSAA staff.
 - C. Each Sport Chair will have at his/her disposal a budget of \$250.00 for expenses occurred such as postage or telephone calls. Receipts for the bills up to \$250.00 should be forwarded to the KCA Executive Director/Treasurer for reimbursement. The KCA will also provide the Sports Chairs with letterhead and envelopes (contact the secretary).
2. Each Sport Chair is responsible for surveying coaches in their sport to determine a Coach of the Year recipient. Coach of the Year recipients must be members of the KCA. Please review the Coach of the Year Guidelines included in this packet.
3. Other responsibilities.....
 - A. Each Sport Chair is requested to supply a list of preferred clinic speakers for the August Coaching School to the KCA president and to David Cherry, KSHSAA, in early December.
 - B. Sport Chairs are encouraged to write short articles for publication on the KCA website. Each sport has a subsection for its use and any information will be posted including notice of vacancies, surveys, or articles.
 - C. Encourage all coaches to join the KCA.
 - D. Attend the KCA business meeting during the KSHSAA Coaching School in August in Topeka.

Coach of the Year Awards

Each Sport Chair is responsible for selecting a "Coach of the Year" for their sport. This award is presented at the KSHSAA Coaching School in August. The Sport Chair is responsible for copying the "Coach of the Year Recipient" form (found on the next page), completing it, and forwarding it to the KCA 1st Vice President. These forms are due to the 1st Vice President on the following dates:

Fall Sports (Cross Country, Football, Girls Golf, Boys Soccer, Girls Tennis, and Volleyball) are due by **December 1**.

Winter Sports (Basketball, Bowling, Gymnastics (Even Years), Wrestling) are due by **March 31**.

Spring Sports (Baseball, Boys Golf, Middle School, Girls Soccer, Softball, Swimming, Boys Tennis, Track) are due by **June 1**.

Guidelines to consider for Coach of the Year nominees:

1. Any head coach of a Junior High, Middle School, or Senior high is eligible for recognition.
2. Classification of schools (6A, 5A, 4A, etc.) is not an important factor. The KCA award is for the coach in each sport who is deemed worthy of recognition by his/her peers.
3. Win/loss record.
4. Post season competition.
5. The recipient of the KCA Coach of the Year Award must be a member of the KCA.
6. A past recipient of the Coach of the Year Award is ineligible to receive that award for the next three years.
